rs. Annalesa "Annie" Woody, age 65, formerly of Hartford, passed away, Tuesday, May 1, 2018 in Austin, Texas after a short bout with cancer.

Annalesa was born in Newport on August 28, 1952. She was raised in the Grassy Fork community having professed her Christian faith at an early age at the Mt. Zion Baptist Church. For the past forty years, she has called Austin her home away from home where she developed lifelong friends.


