John was born in Sullivan, IL on February 8, 1938. He served three years in the United States Army and was a graduate of Sullivan High School in Sullivan, IL and of the University of Illinois. John also attended Belmont College in Nashville, TN. He was a Lab Technician at Great Lakes Chemical in Newport for sixteen years and taught math at Cocke County High School in Newport for nine years.
