Obituary

Y. J. McAndrew age 86 of Dandridge died Saturday May 23, 2014 at the Jefferson Memorial Hospital, Jefferson City. He was a Member of the Dandridge First United Methodist Church. He graduated from the Maury High School, served in the US Navy for one year in the Pacific. Upon returning he entered the East Tennessee State University receiving His Bachelors Degree. He also lettered in track while attending the University. He received his master's degree from the University of Tennessee while teaching at the White Pine School. He was Superintendent of Schools for Jefferson County for 16 years. He was also appointed by the Governor as representative for the State Department of Education East Reagion. He and His wife Barbara started and ran the McAndrew Motor Inn in Pigeon Forge for many years. He was preceded in death by his wife of over fifty years, Barbara Trentham McAndrew in 2011. He was also preceded by his parents Edward Mitchell and Lucy M. Rinehart McAndrew, brothers and sisters Inman McAndrew, James Mitchell McAndrew, Josie McAndrew, William Alfred McAndrew and Lucille McAndrew Rainwater.
